COVID-19 Update for Parents 29th April 2020

Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to inform you as to the arrangements that have been made for the start of Term 2 tomorrow. Importantly school is open for all parents and carers who choose to send their children. We look forward to seeing the children back at school.

Drop Off – Pick Ups

As per Department of Education guidelines parents are asked not to enter the school grounds. This means that the school gates will not open till 7.45am. They will close at 8.15am and all late arrivals must come through the front office and collect a late note. The staff carpark gates will be closed and parents are asked to phone the front office in order for the gates to be opened.

ECE – students are to be dropped off by either their parent/carer or older sibling at the Pre Primary gate. Parents are to say a quick goodbye at the gate and children will then be escorted into their classroom by a staff member. At pick up time please wait at the carpark until you see your child's teacher who will send your child to the gate for pick up.

ILC – please escort students to the gates at the rear of the centre where students will be collected by staff.

Years 1 to 6 – gates off Cryer Court and Dakas Street will be opened at 7.45am and closed at 8.15am. Parents will be required to drop off and collect students from these gates at the end of school (2.10pm)

Work Packages

Work packages for students who indicated prior that they require one will be available for collection from Cable Beach Primary School Cryer Court carpark between 10.30 and 11.30 am tomorrow morning 29th April.

Parents and carers are requested to queue, remain in car and a staff member will provide you with the work package. The work packs are designed for two weeks.

On Line Learning

As indicated last term, On Line learning via Seesaw, is available for students learning from home.

Cleaning

We have increased cleaning of the playgrounds and school equipment significantly however some services will not be operating. These include:

- Water Fountains – please bring water bottles as advised last term. All water fountains will be turned off till further notice.
- School canteen will not operate this week. Please keep abreast of the latest developments from the P&C.

Hand washing at the start of school, before and after breaks will be reinforced as per information distributed last term. Alcohol based hand sanitiser will be available to all classrooms as soon as stock arrives.

Sick Students

As always we encourage parents to ensure that if children are unwell they are kept at home. This advice is even more important given the COVID 19 conditions at present.
